

LEGAL NOTICE

Special education services for children attending private, parochial and home schools.

Mid-Valley Special Education Cooperative, on behalf of its member districts receives federal funding through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) to provide services for students with disabilities. A portion of these funds are set aside to provide limited services for students attending private and parochial schools and for those who are home schooled, by the school district in which the school they attend is located, in accordance with that District's annual plan. School Districts and public agency screening is available to identify possible disabling conditions in children ages 0-21 to determine the need for special services. Parents, school staff, or others may direct their inquiries regarding this information to the Director of Special Education in the school district where the student is educated, including Community Unit School Districts 101 (Batavia), 301, (Central), 302 (Kaneland), 303 (St. Charles), and 304 (Geneva),
